In order to better understand Asian Perspectives on the Protection of the Underwater Cultural Heritage, Dalian Maritime University will hold a series of Asian Regional Workshop on the Protection of Underwater Cultural Heritage; an emerging field in Asian international law and policy.

The first workshop, invites high-level government officials, policy-makers, practitioners, and academics from across the region to examine how their respective Asian nation is working toward the protection of Underwater Cultural Heritage through legislative, policy and practical responses. These responses may include but not be limited to, domestic legislation, transnational diplomacy, bilateral agreement, soft law, and the signing or ratification - or not - of the 2001 UNESCO Convention on the Protection of the Underwater Cultural Heritage.

Current legislative regimes in the region will be explored, national priorities examined, key issues discussed and future directions proposed, alongside rationales for the ratification of the 2001 Convention, or investigation of the issues preventing nations which have not yet ratified, or which ultimately choose not to, from doing so.

Each panel speaker has 20 minutes for their presentation. The official workshop language is English.
